



MemorialsLeaving a legacy, remembering the life of someone and their discipleship to Jesus Christ, and many other motivations contribute to persons who want to share a memorial gift to Grace Church. Here is some information about the process.

- 1) At the time of death as I meet with the family we discuss the wishes of the family in terms of a memorial request.**
- 2) When a memorial is desired the family is asked if it is to be designated for a special purpose or designated for a general purpose as the needs arise.**
- 3) Cards and envelopes are provided at no charge to the family and made available at the viewing/funeral as well as kept for one year at the church in the Eastern hallway between the sanctuary and the Sunday School Auditorium.**
- 4) Upon receipt of the gift a thank you note from the pastor is mailed to the donor.**
- 5) The Special Funds Committee under the direction of the Trustees administer these memorial donations. Requests for the use of these funds may be submitted by any group, ministry or mission of the church.**
- 6) Two or three weeks after the funeral, a list of names, addresses and the total amount given is sent to a contact person from the family. This is updated on a periodic basis.**
- 7) Annually, on the First Sunday of November, All Saints Sunday, a list of projects and items that have been supported or purchased through the past year is printed in our memorial printout.**

Memorials are a great way of remembering our family members and friends who have died and were connected to the mission and life of Grace Church by Sharing God's Amazing Grace as we Journey Along Life's Highway.
